Results Tollgate Canyon Area Property Owners Survey

April 2006

Summary

- Survey sent to 850 property owners within Tollgate Canyon Area.
 53% response rate (450 households responded)
- There are a significant number of people using Tollgate Canyon on any given day. All combined, the 450 respondents identified 7494 users of their property. An estimate to include non-responders is approx. 10,000 users last year.
- 24% of responding households who are not primary residents use their property more than 50 days each year
- 31% of part time residents plan to make Tollgate Canyon their full-time (primary) residence in the future
- 70% of land-owners who responded have plans to build with 24% of those planning primary residences
- Fire Prevention & safety, EMS and Road Safety were all strong concerns, with Fire Prevention being the most important
- The projected growth suggests we need to act quickly to address Emergency
 Preparedness

Use of Tollgate Canyon

- There are a significant number of people using Tollgate Canyon on any given day.
 - 85 full time *households* in Tollgate Canyon with an estimated 2.3 people per household (according to numbers provided by survey respondents)
 - 24% of all non full-time residents use their property 50+ days each year
 - LDS Properties owns a Girl Scout Camp that is used by 3,000+ people each
 - Brighton Meadows LDS Church Property is used by approximately 1950 people
 - Murray South Stake has 480 people who used their Tollgate Canyon property
 - Other survey respondents identified 20 85 people using their property
 - All combined, the 450 respondents identified 7494 users of their property. The number is still significant at 2066 if we exclude the aforementioned three properties.

Responders by Type of Residency


 Primary and secondary residents responded at a slightly higher rate than they are represented in the population.

Known population figures:

- -101 full time (Primary) residences: 12% of pop.
- 300 part-time (Secondary) residences: 35% of pop
- 450 land owners (no structure): 47% of pop

Rate of Response to Survey:

- Primary residences: 17%
- Secondary residences: 39%
- Land Owners: 43% of pop

 While the majority of non residents use their property in the summer, an increasing number are using their property on a year-round basis (32% of people that answered the question)

Land-Owner Intent to Build

- 70% of land-owners intend to build
 - out of the 53% survey response 120 new homes are expected
- 45% of building planned within next 3 years
 - out of the 53% survey response 54 new homes in the next three years
- 24% of builders plan to make Tollgate their full-time home


